It is our vision to establish a scenario for the smooth transition of students from academic to professional lives. We give opportunity for right students at right time at right place.





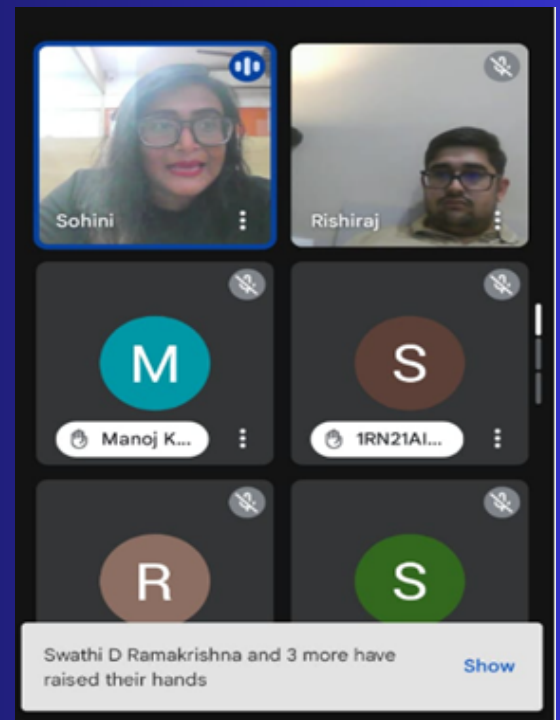
